RESIDENT MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

2. The application form must be completed and signed by the resident and reviewed and signed by the Program Director.
3. After receipt of all required materials, the resident will be confirmed as a Resident Member of the Triological Society. The Council reserves the final decision on the qualifications of any candidate.
4. As a resident member, a subscription to The Laryngoscope will be sent to the member. Application materials may be submitted at any time during the year.
5. Senior residents who will complete residency training in the Spring are encouraged to apply as Post-Graduate members.

 - Applicant photo (requested, not required)
